The Maine State Chamber Purchasing Alliance, Inc. is offering small businesses with 2 to 50 employees Chamber BlueOptions® health plans from Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield in Maine. This suite of health plans is available exclusively to members of local or regional chambers of commerce.

Chamber BlueOptions includes a variety of plans with different deductibles and coinsurance levels, featuring preferred provider organization (PPO) plans, HMOs, and Health Savings Account (HSA) plans.

When your business enrolls in Chamber BlueOptions, each employee may choose the plan that best fits their needs, with only 60% of eligible employees required for group coverage.

In addition, Purchasing Alliance employers with 15 or more enrolled employees can qualify for a 3% discount on annual premiums by engaging in certain wellness activities. The 3% discount would become available at annual renewal.

- Access to pertinent disability hiring information;
- A network of employers who share information on common disability employment issues;
- Exposure to qualified job applicants and disabilities;
- Opportunities to provide training and work experience for job seekers with disabilities; and,
- Improved access to customers with disabilities.

Many Business Leadership Networks were established as part of a national initiative started by the Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP) and supported by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce. The U.S. Business Leadership Network (USBLN) is now the national organization providing guidance and support.
